IN PERSON:

Your 2016 Total Income must have been under \$54,000

Have an IRS-certified volunteer prepare your taxes at a Volunteer Income Tax Assistance (VITA) site

ONLINE: at home | at Facilitated Self Assistance sites | at other public computers

Your 2016 Total Income must have been under \$64,000

YOU QUALIFY IF:

- You had Income from wages, self-employment, or government benefits in 2016 You do not own Rental Property
- You did not declare Bankruptcy in 2016
- You did not receive Military Pay
- If you are self-employed, you did not have employees or inventory and your business expenses were less than \$10,000

WHAT TO BRING:

Proof of identification (photo ID)

Social Security cards for you, your spouse and dependents or an Individual Taxpayer Identification Number (ITIN) or proof of foreign status, if applying for an ITIN

Birth dates for you, your spouse and dependents on the tax return

Wage and earning statements (Form W-2, W-2G, 1099-R, 1099-Misc) from all employers

Interest and dividend statements from banks (Forms 1099)

All Forms 1095, Health Insurance Statements

Health Insurance Exemption Certificate, if received

A copy of last year's federal and state returns, if available

To file taxes electronically on a married-filing-joint tax return, both spouses must be present to sign the required forms

Total paid for daycare provider and daycare provider's tax identifying # (providers Social Security # or business employer ID #)

Forms 1095-A, B, or C, Affordable Health Care Statements

Copies of income transcripts from IRS and state, if applicable

For faster return: Savings and/or checking account routing numbers or blank check for direct deposit
